PACKING LUNCHES FOR HOMELESS - Our church has committed to purchasing supplies and packing sack lunches for the homeless. We assemble 150 lunches during each shift in our church fellowship hall and deliver them to staff at the Chattanooga Community Kitchen, who pass the lunches out at various homeless encampments around town. This project is directly connected to COVID-19; the homeless would typically come to the Chattanooga Community Kitchen for meals in its dining hall, but the dining hall is closed to encourage social distancing for this highly vulnerable population. STUDENT AID – An unprecedented number of Adventist academy students from our church presented a serious financial challenge.
