STUDENT AID - An unprecedented number of Adventist academy students from our church presented a serious financial challenge. This project is directly connected to COVID-19; the homeless would typically come to the Chattanooga Community Kitchen for meals in its dining hall, but the dining hall is closed to encourage social distancing for this highly vulnerable population.
